THEME REQUIREMENTS FOR PWD IN PHOTO:

January/February 2007 issue

PWD must have received a water certificate or title in 2006.

March/April 2007 issue

PWD must have received a title in obedience, tracking, rally or agility in 2006.

May/June 2007 issue

PWD must have made the Top Ten in 2006 in any category.

July/August 2007 issue

PWD is a pet, new champion (1/06-6/07), rescue or veteran.

September/October 2007 issue

PWD must be a brood bitch or stud dog with all health tests current and in accordance with PWDCA ad policy.

Photos of PWD puppies are also eligible if sire/dam meet above health test requirement w/certificates supplied w/entry.

HOW TO ENTER:

- PWD featured in photo/art submitted must be owned by a member of the PWDCA.
- No show photos please. NO EMAILED PHOTOS accepted.
- Submit entry as a high quality photographic print by issue deadline date. You MUST enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope for the return of entry.
- ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE PHOTOGRAPHER OR ARTIST PLUS OWNER FOR PUBLICATION.

You must attach this entry form lightly to the back of each entry with a single piece of clear tape and send to *Courier* office. No entries accepted without this form.
